We are committed to protecting the privacy and security of the personal information that we receive from our clients and process on their behalf and would like such processing to be open and transparent. Our data management activities are always carried out in compliance with the applicable laws, primarily the Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council, Act CXII of 2011 on the Protection of Personal Data and the Disclosure of Information of Public Interest (Data Protection Act) as well as other applicable laws concerning data protection.

In this privacy policy, we have set out the personal data controlling activities of the company, our personal data management practices, and the organizational and technical measures are taken to protect personal data as well as the the rights of the effected parties.

2. DATA CONTROLLING ACTIVITIES

Data controlling in relation to our website.

You are not required to provide any personal information on the public areas of this website. However, you may choose to submit your personal data – primarily your name and e-mail address - by completing the form under the contact section of our website to get in contact with our company. The personal data provided here will be used by our company for the purpose of contact, and they will be deleted immediately after the contact process has been completed. Our company will not save them and will not build a newsletter database from them. In such cases, our company will use your personal data based on your consent.

Cookies

We also obtain technical information and data from your IP address, operating system, and web browser that you use to access our website. Cookies store information about the relationship between the user and their web server. The cookies help assess the functionality, efficiency, errors and the number of visitors, and support to increase the user experience, which is also the purpose of data management. Cookies do not retrieve information about you stored on your hard drive and do not corrupt or damage your computer or computer files. You are not obliged

to accept a cookie that we send to you, and you can in fact modify your browser so that it will not accept cookies.

Data controlling in relation to our docking stations ('Dokkoló®').

Our company acts as a data controller if you use our docking stations (Dokkoló®). In accordance with your needs and consent, we may control the following personal data:

To refund the deposit of the bottles to you by bank transfer, our company will control your name, bank account number, and e-mail address that you have provided to our company.

Our company will control your e-mail address to redeem the bottle deposit fee in the form of a coupon. Your email address will be deleted immediately after sending the coupon.

In such cases, our company will use your personal data based on your consent.

Data controlling in relation to invoicing.

If you would like to request a VAT invoice from our company, you can contact our company by sending the transaction ID seen on the interface of our docking stations to the following e-mail address hello@only.hu. The personal data provided via e-mail will be controlled for the purpose of issuing a VAT invoice. Your email address will be deleted immediately after the invoice has been issued and sent. In such cases, our company controls your personal data based on a legal obligation.

Other data controlling activity.

Furthermore, our company controls personal and contact data, which are essential for the conclusion of an agreement, performance of our services, and compliance with various applicable laws and regulations. This data may include (varying in accordance with the type of service provided) name, address, telephone number, date of birth and other personal data concerning your preferences relevant to our service. For the provision of our services, we may also control financial and payment data, such as bank account details and other data necessary for processing payments and fraud prevention.

3. TRANSFER, SUB-PROCESSORS, AND DATA SECURITY

The personal data you provide to our company will be transferred to a third party only if you request a VAT invoice from our company and provide personal information to our company for this purpose. In all other instances, the personal data you provide will not be transferred to third parties, i.e. our subcontractors will not carry out any data processing activities for our company in relation to your personal data.

Our company has adequate security measures in place to prevent your provided data from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed. All our employees who process your personal information are obliged to respect the confidentiality of your information.

4. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS

You may request details from us as data controllers of the information we hold about you and how we process it. There are exceptions to this right, so that access may be denied if, for example, making the information available to you would reveal personal data about another person, or if we are legally prevented from disclosing such information. You may request the correction, limitation or deletion of data processing of your data that we process, and we encourage you to do so through the contact details in Section 5.

You may object to the processing of personal data and you may request us to block, erase and restrict your personal data. You also have the right to data portability, you may request that some of your personal data is provided to you, or to another data controller, in a commonly used, machine-readable format. Furthermore, you have the right to erase your personal data when the personal data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, or when, among other things, your personal data have been unlawfully processed

In the event of a violation of your data subject's rights, you may seek remedy through the National Data Protection and Information Authority, or to seek a remedy through the courts.
